



Bond Cleaning List

With any clean we must prepare the areas first, especially if you have had pets inside. Pet hair can greatly increase cleaning time.

- 1- Remove all spider webs from cornicing and behind doors.
- 2- Vacuum all skirting boards and along carpet/tile edges.
- 3- Dust and Clean blinds paying particular attention to insect poo dots, ensure that you do back and front of blinds. If you need to wet blinds please only use warm water with a small dot of detergent and micro fibre cloths
- 4- Vacuum all floors.

Keeping up with maintenance cleans especially your bathrooms, toilets, kitchen and floors will also save time. Please don't think that because you have engaged a cleaner that you don't have to clean common areas for a month before, you will find that the longer these areas are left the more build up will happen especially mould in the shower and grease/oils in the kitchen.

If you want to do any extra than above its best to do complete rooms for eg. Everything in the main bedroom from top to bottom to bond clean standards. If we think that it can be better and not to bond clean standards we will need to redo, we are trained professionals and know the standard that Real Estates and Landlords expect.

If you are cleaning wall's please DO NOT use sugar soap, gumption or abrasive chemicals as this can damage or leave walls with residue which will require us to sometimes rinse a number of times to remove.
